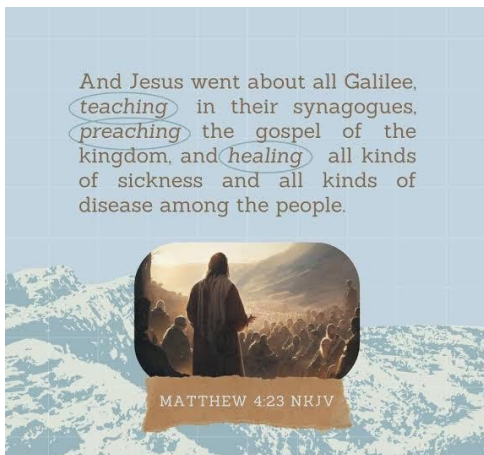
## Bible Study in June
