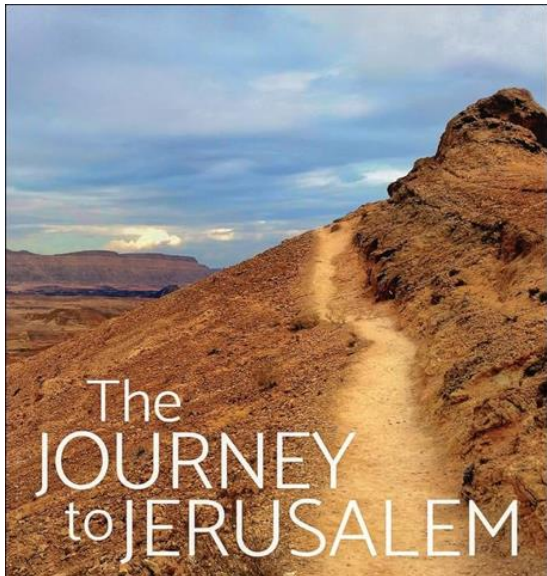

SOUP-er February

It's getting cold outside again and our Shelter guests will appreciate a hot cup of soup when they arrive. Our goal is to provide this for every evening in February. On Saturday nights, when we open late at 10PM, we will provide a sandwich. SIX volunteers are needed to bring soup on the 12th, 14th, 16th, 25th, 26th, and 28th. Plus we need ONE person to make sandwiches for Saturday, the 17th.



Code Purple

From December 1 through March 15, GPC houses up to 14 men who need a warm, safe place for the night. **We can only open if we have sufficient volunteers!!**

INTAKE/REGISTRATION (2 people) takes place from 8:00pm to 8:30pm. Can you commit one night a week or a month to help our guests sign in and get their cots/bedding out for the night?

CHAPERONES (2 people) are needed each night to be with the guests as they sleep. The chaperones have cots set up in the kitchen. They need to arrive by 8:00pm (10pm Saturdays) and leave at 7am the next morning. Is this something you might consider?

RESET crews (1 - 2 people) come in between 7:00am to 11:00am. This takes between 45 to 90 minutes to sweep the floor, wipe down cots, take out the trash, and clean the bathrooms.

HEALTHY EVENING SNACKS are helpful as our guests arrive cold, sometimes wet, often hungry, and ready to sleep. They appreciate something warm to eat before they sleep. (We need 14 per night.) To donate food, place it in a bag in the Food Cart. Please mark the bag "Shelter".
