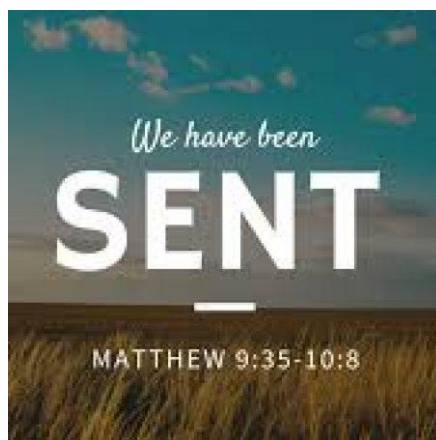

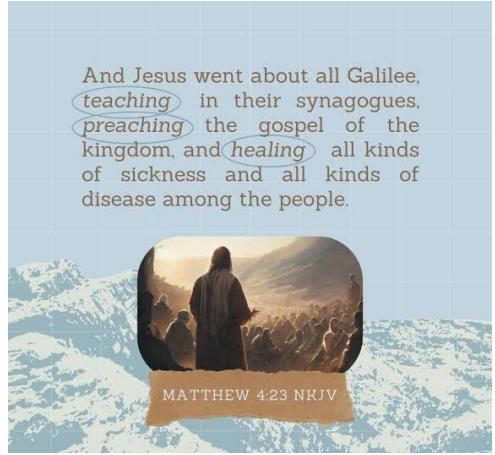


Bible Study in June
